Azure Accelerate fast-tracks decision-making by generating business cases that incorporate Azure Windows Hybrid Benefits, Reserved Instances, Azure Savings Plans, and more.

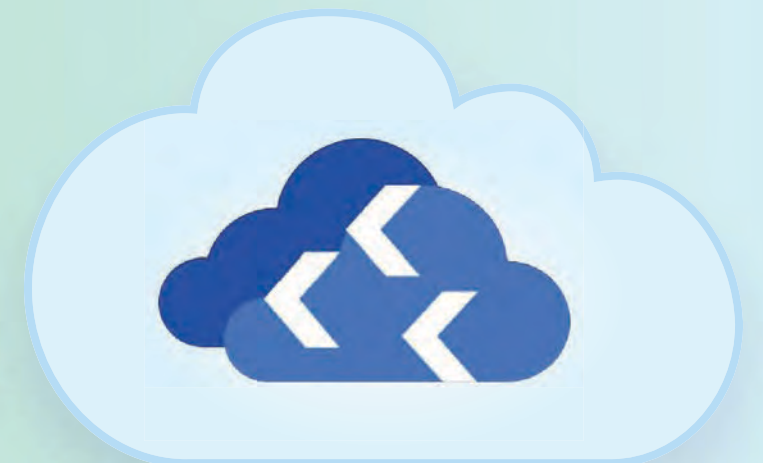
The report also provides a financial analysis that compares total cost of ownership (TCO) between on-premises environments and Azure, including payback periods and other key metrics.

Subsidized Services

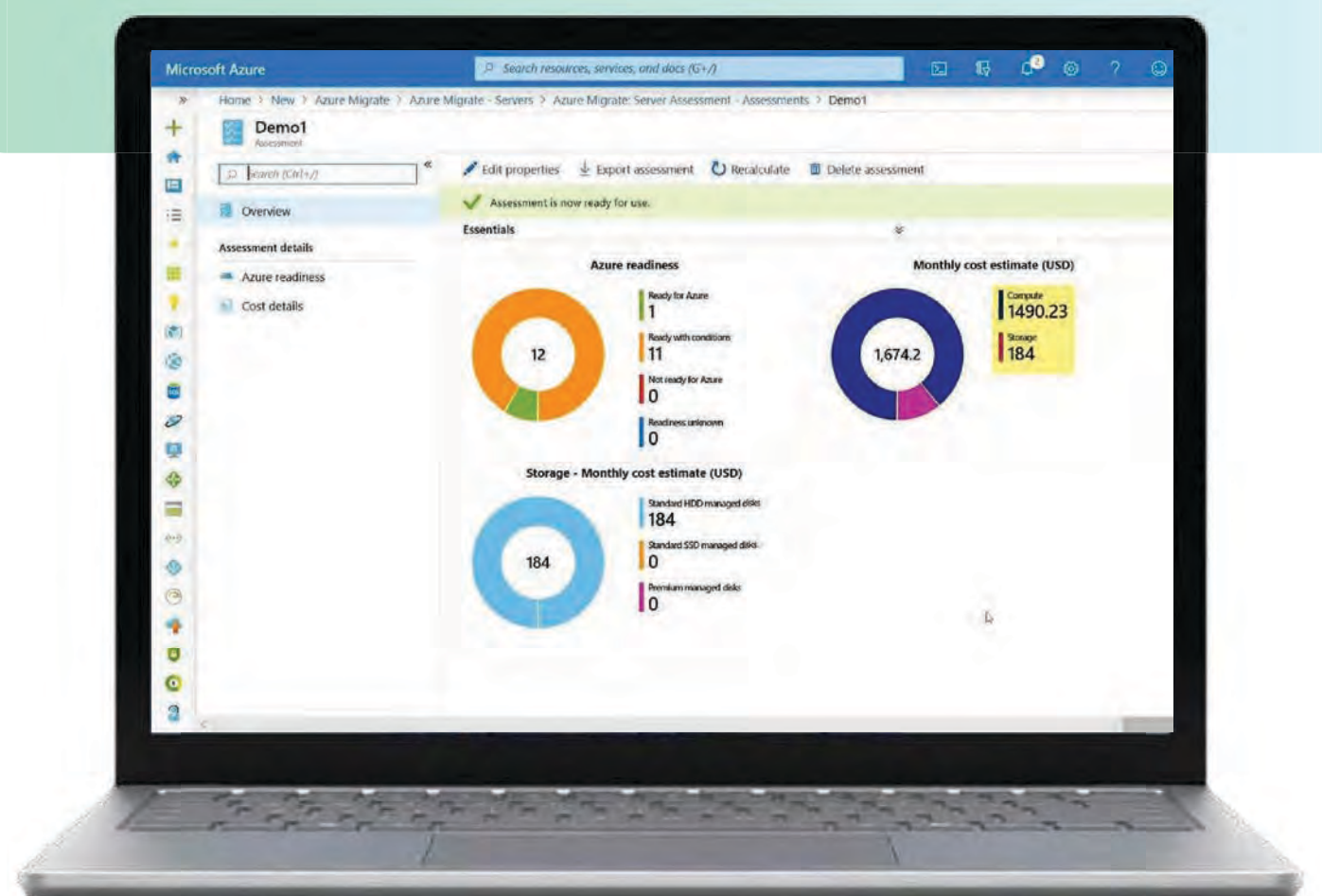
Ingram Micro subsidizes up to \$5,000 of service delivery costs per customer, even in shared environments.

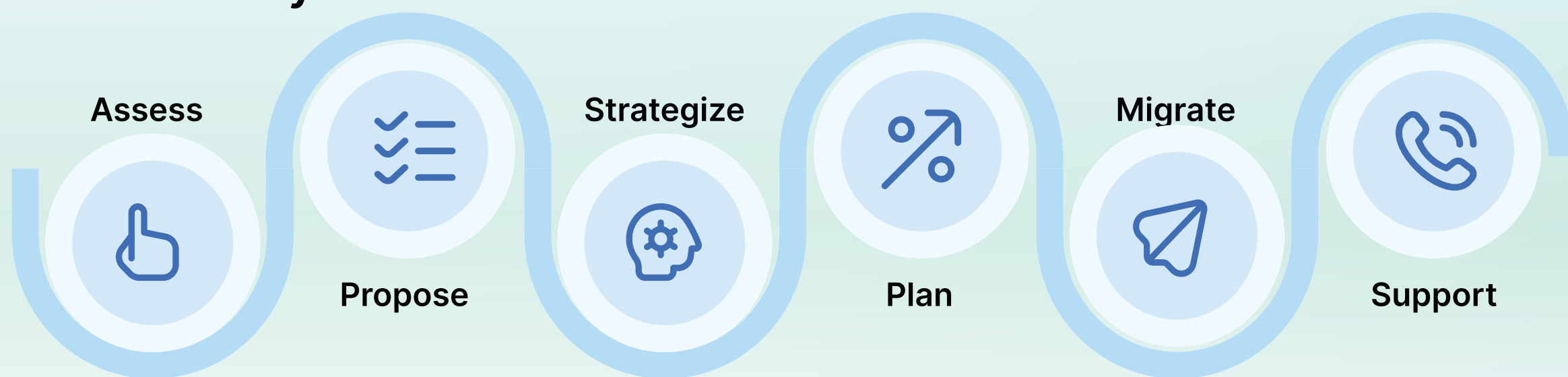

Engagement Scope

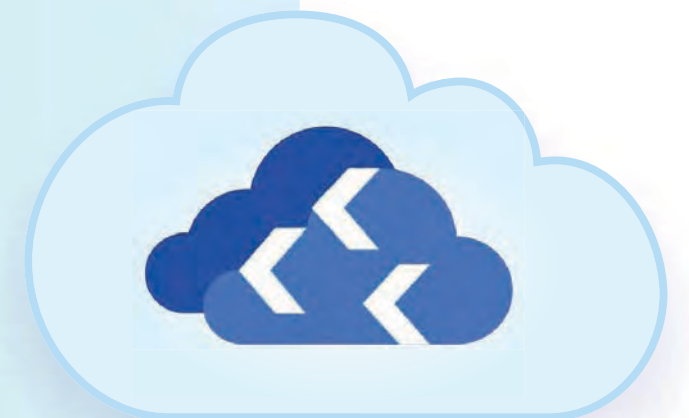
Provide expert guidance to execute an infrastructure and database migration to Azure or to migrate a customer's Windows desktops and apps to Azure.

Azure Accelerate helps simplify and accelerate customer migration and modernization projects.

As part of this engagement, Ingram Micro will conduct an application compatibility assessment, establish or review the landing zone, and complete all migration and deployment tasks, including securing the Azure workloads.

Azure Accelerate supports the following migration scenarios

- Migration of a VMware environment to Azure native or Azure VMware Solution (AVS)
- Migration of Windows Server, Linux, SQL Server, and open-source databases to Azure
- Hybrid deployments with Azure Arc
- Migration of Windows desktops and apps to Azure Virtual Desktop, Citrix Cloud on Azure or VMware Horizon Cloud Service for Azure
- Deployment of greenfield Azure Virtual Desktop, Citrix Cloud on Azure or VMware Horizon Cloud Service for Azure



To qualify for funding, Ingram Micro must perform all migration activities – migrations cannot be co-delivered with reseller partners, nor can Ingram Micro claim funding on behalf of resellers for work performed by those resellers.

Customer must complete a survey at project completion. Public Sector customers located in India, United States, or Puerto Rico must also sign a Public Sector Disclosure (PSD).

Azure-to-Azure migrations, including EA2CSP and Paygo2CSP, are not eligible for Azure Accelerate.

Engagement Funding

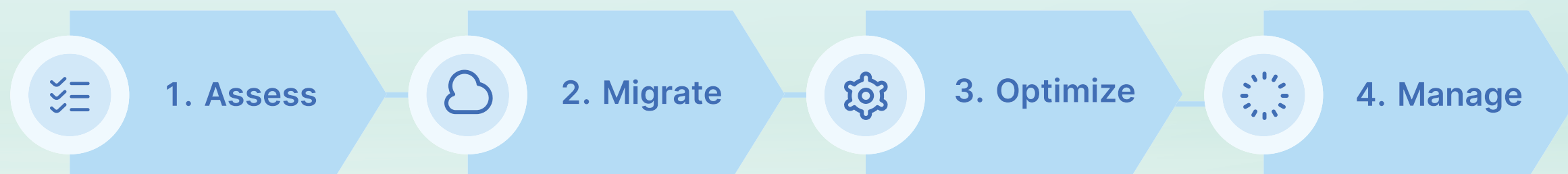
Funding amounts are determined based on the projected Azure consumption after migration or deployment. Azure Consumed Revenue (ACR) can be calculated with the [Azure Pricing Calculator](#). Ingram Micro receives a fixed payment based on the project's size category (XXS, XS, Small, Medium, or Large), determined by the customer's first-year Azure consumption estimate. Payments are fixed once the size category is established. All funding amounts listed below are in USD.
